There are certain products which are prepared using Aonla such as **Juice, RTS, Squash, Murabbas, Pickles, Candy, Jelly, Jam** etc. For the purpose of value addition as well as from the perspective of reduction in post-harvest losses in Aonla crop, Horticultural Crop Processing Division, ICAR-Central Institute of Post-Harvest Engineering and Technology (ICAR-CIPHET), Abohar is going to organize a EDP and hands on training for 3 days starting from 29th February to 2nd March 2016.
