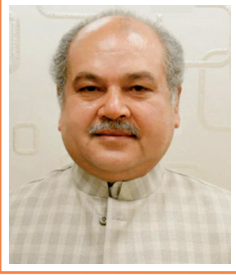

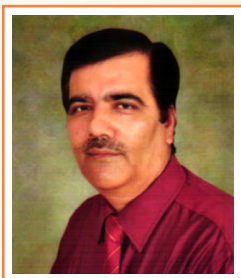

## PRELUDE

## Preface

---

The concept of Agro-Processing Center was propagated since 1980s and various ICAR institutes/ schemes supported farmer-entrepreneurs in establishment of APCs. First model agro-processing centre was established in the CIAE campus under the AICRP on PHT Scheme in 1985. The centre was constructed in 16 × 8 m plinth area. Selected equipment installed at the centre included CIAE dal mill, hand operated double screen grain cleaner, pedal-cum-power operated cleaner, mini grain mill, commercial burr mill (Atta Chakki), grain flour separator, oil expeller, sealing/bagging unit, storage bins etc. The total cost of the equipment/machines installed at the centre was INR 70,000 (approx.).

In general, the agro-processing centers are now operated as enterprise or on custom hiring cum enterprise mode. Most of these APCs process multiple commodities, however some such centers are working on single specialised commodity too. The major schemes promoting the concept of APC and providing necessary handholding are ICAR-CIPHET, Ludhiana; ICAR-CIAE, Bhopal; All India Coordinated Research Project on Post-Harvest Engineering and Technology (AICRP on PHET), Krishi Vigyan Kendra and Consortia Research Project on Secondary Agriculture (CRP on SA).

This document has been prepared as a general guideline for establishment of APCs and highlighting some enterprises as successful models operating in different parts of the country. The information about APCs is arranged in this document in the order of number of APCs in state. The economics and impact, wherever not mentioned specifically, are pertaining to the market prices of the year 2020-21.

It has been very well recognized that processing of agro commodities would bring prosperity among the producers and post-harvest processing has become a buzz word among the government as well as non-government organizations. It is expected that this document would help such stakeholders in planning their activities, choosing right business, and learning from success stories.

## Summary

---

Agro-processing centre (APC) is a place where series of techno-economic activities are carried out for processing and value addition of agricultural produce and by-products, and to make them usable as food, feed, fibre, fuel or industrial raw material. Establishing an agro-processing centre in production catchment is the need of hour in view to process the agricultural produce and to add some value, make the produce convenient to use which in turn would provide employment and improve farmer's income and livelihood.

Some estimates suggest that in developed countries, about 14% of the total work force is engaged in agro-processing sector directly or indirectly. However, in India, only about 3% of the work force finds employment in this sector revealing its underdeveloped state and vast untapped potential for employment.

The concept of establishment of APCs was originally initiated by ICAR AICRP on Post Harvest Engineering & Technology (PHET) in eighties. The major institutes promoting the concept of APC and also providing necessary handholding in establishment of APC are ICAR-Central Institute of Post Harvest Engineering and Technology, Ludhiana; ICAR-Central Institute of Agricultural Engineering, Bhopal; All India Coordinated Research Project on Post-Harvest Engineering and Technology (AICRP on PHET), Krishi Vigyan Kendra; Consortia Research Project on Secondary Agriculture (CRP on SA) and Farmer's FIRST programme of ICAR.

There are six proposed models of agro-processing centers: Model-I: Agro-Processing Centre for Primary Processing of Food Grains, Oilseeds, Pulses and Spices; Model-II: Mini Rice Mill, Extruded Products; Model-III: Agro-Processing Centre for Potato and Extruded products; Model-IV: Turmeric and Ginger Drying and Grinding; Model-V: Minimal Processing, Drying and Powdering, Value Added Products; Model-VI: Sugarcane Juice Bottling Plant and Jaggery Unit. Other APC models can also be established according

to requirement and availability of raw produce in a particular area. It has been suggested that establishment of multi-machinery, multi-commodity processing centers would be a viable proposition wherein variety of machines with reasonable capacities could be installed and some of such machines could perform in processing of more than one crop. Further, it has also been noticed that certain geographic locations have advantage of certain production or demand, hence specialized product-based APCs were promoted.

Efforts of ICAR have resulted in establishment of nearly 300 Agro-processing centres spread all over India, out of which 270 APCs are in operation, and successfully producing and marketing the processed products. The annual turnover of each APC is ranging between 0.70 to 60.0 lakh and giving direct employment to 3-6 people and indirect upto 10 people depending upon the initial investment. An exchequer of INR 20438.63 crore can be saved if the amount of existing loss of food grains is to be processed into value added products.

In this document, the details of 177 successful agro-processing centres, which are operational in the country, are presented.

## INTRODUCTION

Post-harvest processing is one of the necessary steps in loss prevention and conversion of raw material to edible form. In this process value addition to agricultural produce also takes place. It is an essential operation being carried out prior to consumption of agro produce. This sector occupies a unique position in the Indian economy in terms of its potential for employment generation, increasing the farmers' income and export growth. The establishment of agro-processing centre is the present need in the production area for processing the agricultural produce, which would improve farmer's income and livelihood in a sustainable manner. Entrepreneurship on small scale is the solution to the problem of unemployment and proper utilization of both human and non-human resources and improving the living condition of the poor. This also prevents storage and transportation of inedible/ un-processible product from production catchments to the urban or peri-urban consumption areas.

### Agro-Processing Centre

A set of techno-economic activities carried out for conservation and handling of agricultural produce and to make it usable as food, feed, fibre, fuel or industrial raw material is defined as agro-processing. It includes all the unit operations from the stage of harvesting till the material reaches the end consumers in the desired form (Kachru, 2010). It is a place or subset of manufacturing where all the facilities required for pre-treatment, processing, drying, packaging, storage and marketing (optional) are available in a sequential manner for the raw materials and intermediate products derived from the agricultural sector. Agro-processing centre is comprised of different sectors in food processing such as fruits & vegetables, cereals or other consumer food products, rice milling, flour milling, pulse processing, spices grinding, oilseeds processing and other agro-horticultural sectors. An APC creates additional value to a product so as to increase marketability of surplus produce available in the village, cluster of villages or surrounding locality. This type of centre can be managed by individuals, co-operatives, community organizations, or voluntary organizations. Therefore, the centre helps in enhancing processing





and preservation of surplus produce and increases income and employment opportunities in rural areas.

Nowadays, the most important rising sector of the Indian economy is regarded as agro-processing on the basis of large potential growth and socio-economic impact on employment and income generation. After green revolution era, India experienced growth in processing industries but still this sector is in its infancy due to lack of knowledge about processing, improper storage facilities and insufficient transportation facilities and lot of post-harvest losses. Some estimates suggest that in developed countries, up to 14 per cent of the total work force is engaged in agro-processing sector directly or indirectly. However, in India, only about 3 per cent of the work force finds employment in this sector revealing its underdeveloped state and vast untapped potential for employment. Government of India has undertaken several initiatives in the recent past in terms of implementation of ease of doing business, creating policy frame work and development of infrastructure facilities to make it easy for organizations in the farming, agriculture and food processing sectors to set up and do business in the country. In the last 5 years, the food processing sector in 2018-19 has been growing at an Average Annual Growth Rate (AAGR) of around 10 per cent as compared to 3.11 per cent in agriculture at 2011-12 prices (Annual Report, MOFPI, 2019-20).

### **Need and Importance of Agro- Processing**

Often farmers do not get sufficient remuneration for their crops inspite of a bumper yield, this leads to distress sale and/or quantitative/ qualitative losses. In a country like India, the post-harvest losses account for about INR 1.52 Lakh Crore per year. Although our farming community toiled hard, the small and marginal segment of farmers could not get real benefit of the growth in the economy due to either non availability of adequate storage infrastructure within the vicinity of production areas or poor access to the godowns. Besides during various post-harvest unit operations, many of secondary products are generated along with the main product. Some parts of these secondary products are not utilized for any commercial application, hence are considered as waste. Moreover, since these secondary products do not have commercial value, they are sometimes disposed carelessly and hence may cause environmental hazard. Giving commercial value to these menacing products, called 'waste', could be an answer to the problem. There could be two products from this 'waste'; value added products (edible, medicinal, industrial) or energy or both. Agro-processing industries could be a viable solution to play a major role in the economy of developing countries. APC can connect the gap between producer

and consumer by ensuring the readiness of food products at proper time and at low cost. Moreover, the APC would create a market demand for processed food products which will motivate the farmer to produce surplus to earn more money. Agro-processing centre adds value to crops by processing, in some cases, by export, earns valuable foreign exchange, provides opportunities for import substitution and benefits a large number of farmers, packaging suppliers and vendors. Further, these units also provide support in eradicating poverty and providing employment opportunities in rural areas. These units also help in eliminating the exploitation of farmers by traders and middle men. These industries facilitate transmission of an industrial culture in rural areas and thereby bring modernization and innovation in agriculture and development of rural entrepreneurship. Thus, the problem of seasonal unemployment, food and nutritional security, migration from rural to urban areas, post-harvest losses etc. can be solved by establishing agro-processing centres.

## 2 STATUS AND IMPACT OF APC's

### Model Designs for APCs

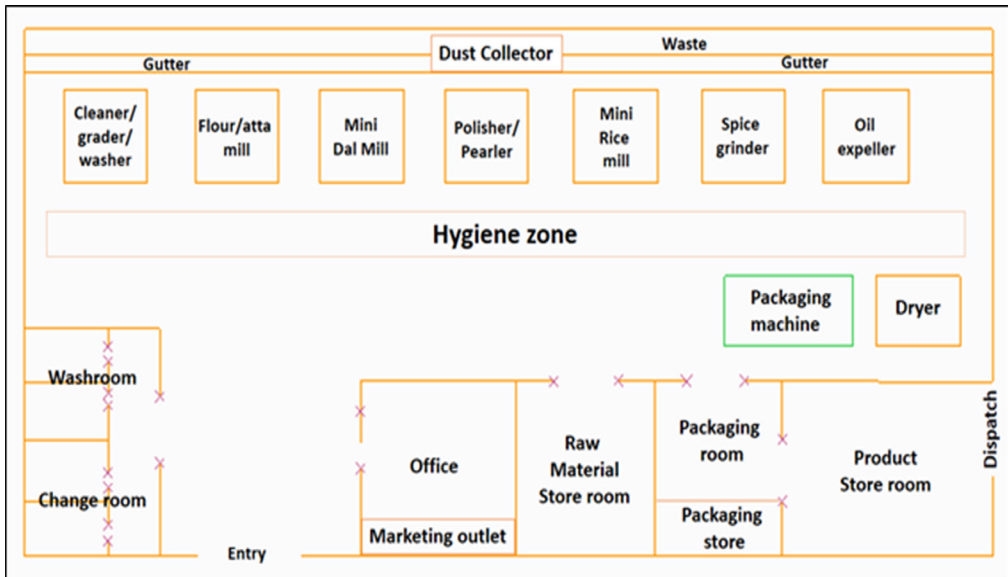


Fig. 1. A typical layout of agro-processing centre

The concept of Agro Processing Center primarily supports multi-commodity processing center wherein the commodities are selected based on production or consumption needs of the area where the APC is established. Hence, the machinery and their layout are expected to be different in different geographic locations. However, there are certain unit operations like cleaning/ grading, milling, packaging, storage, waste disposal, etc. which are common for all commodities besides their specific requirements. Based on these needs and other necessities to maintain hygiene and safety, a typical layout of an Agro Processing Center is presented in Fig 1. Some of the most common models suitable for different parts of India are also shown as examples.

#### Layout of Agro Processing Centre:

**Equipment/Machines Required for AgroProcessing Centre:** While selection of equipment for APC, points to be considered are products to be prepared, raw material availability, capacity of machine, power source, ease in operation, safety in operation, material of manufacturing (should be of food grade), manpower requirement and ease in repair and maintenance of machine. The equipment will be selected on the basis of agricultural commodities available in the area of establishment of APC.

### **Model APC-I: Agro-Processing Centre for Primary Processing of Foodgrains, Oilseeds, Pulses and Spices**

The machines like pre cleaners and graders, mini rice mill, baby oil expeller, small atta chakkies and large atta chakkies with scouring machine, masala grinder, cleaner, dal mill and feed mill are required which may cost approximately INR 25-30 lakh and an amount of INR 6.0-8.0 lakh for construction of APC shed and installation of machinery.

### **Model APC-II: Mini Rice Mill, Extruded Products**

The machines like pre-cleaners, mini rice mill, extruder and its accessories, electric motor etc. are required which may cost approximately INR 30 lakh.

### **Model APC-III Agro-Processing Centre for Potato and Extruded products**

The machines required are graders, potato chips plant, extruder and its accessories which may cost approximately INR 35 lakh.

### **Model APC-IV: Turmeric and Ginger Drying and Grinding**

The machines required are working table, washer, centrifuge, slicer, dicer, tray dryer, pulverizer, packaging and sealing machine etc. which may cost approximately INR 10 lakh.

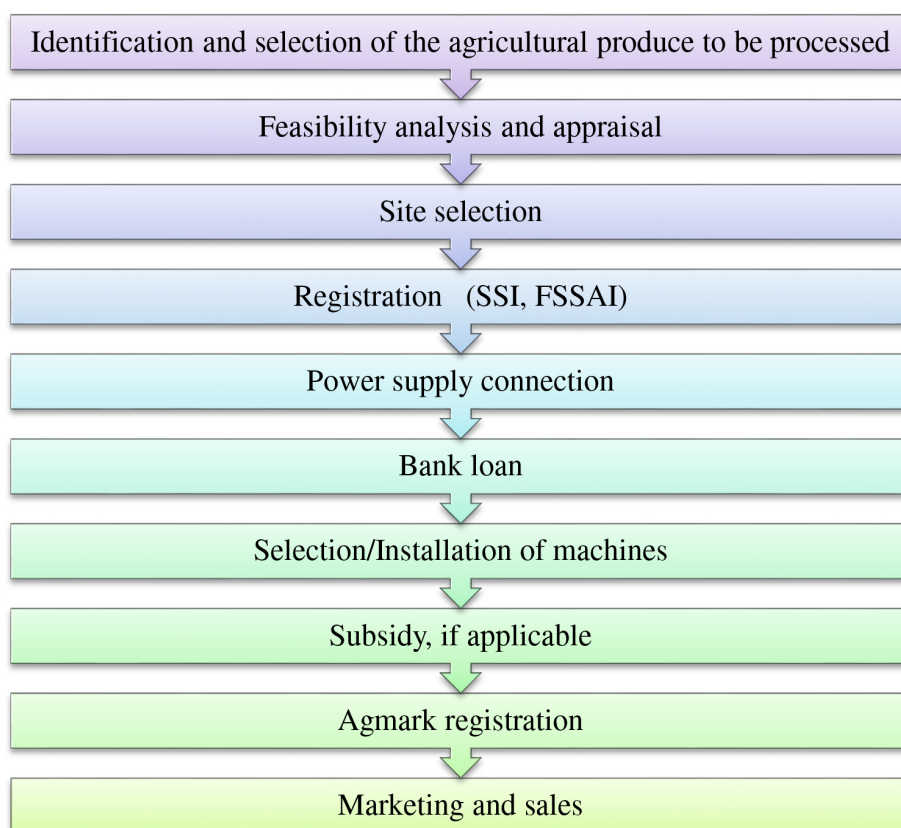
### **Model APC-V: Minimal Processing, Drying and Powdering, Value Added Products**

The machines required are peeler, slicer, pulper, working table, washer, centrifuge, slicer, dicer, tray dryer, pulverizer, packaging and sealing machine, cold storage room etc. which may cost approximately INR 15 lakh.

### **Model APC-VI: Sugarcane Juice Bottling Plant and Jaggery Unit**

The machines required are sugar cane juice bottling plant (crusher, filter, boiler, treatment unit, bottling, corking, sterilizer, crates storage etc.), moulding frame, sieves, boiling pans, etc. which may cost approximately INR 15 lakh.

The general guideline for establishment of an agro processing center is given in Fig. 2. Based on the type of product, location and category of the promoter there could be more steps related to claiming of subsidy or any other government support.

## Impact Assessment of APCs on National Scale

The concept of APC models was pioneered by AICRP on PHET which has been promoting Agro Processing Centres at production catchments by providing technical guidance followed by monitoring. The idea behind it was to prevent capital and human drain from rural to urban area and to reduce post-harvest losses. A comprehensive assessment of APC promoted by AICRP on PHET was carried out during 2008-2010 (Nanda et.al, 2013). The assessment was based on the hypothesis that APC have made impact in terms of reduction of processing and storage losses, higher recovery, cost saving, energy saving, timeliness of operation, premium price for better quality, maintaining hygienic conditions and reduction of drudgery. These factors contribute towards improving the social and economic well-being of different stakeholders. The impact of APC established by AICRP on PHET at national level was examined from economic and social perspective. The primary data was collected using structured interview schedule from 21 Agro Processing Centres located in 9 states.

On an average net profit per APC was estimated to INR 5.24 lakh per annum. Total benefits accrued to the entrepreneurs were estimated by multiplying the number of APCs with adjusted average net benefit after avoiding the extreme values. The study revealed that APC generated INR 4.30 crore net returns per annum to the entrepreneurs and INR 8.20 crore to society (consumers/retailers). The indirect benefits to society are realized through resultant saving of enhanced recovery and additional income to persons who are engaged in the supply of raw material to APC, marketing of value-added products from APC and also reduction in logistic cost to the consumers and/or retailers. A simple estimate put forward that one APC is able to contribute towards saving of INR 10 lakh per annum indirectly to the society, which is nearly double to the direct income of an entrepreneur. Further, on an average, one APC provides direct employment to 4 persons and indirect employment to 6 persons (1.5 times of direct employment) for a period of 240 days in a year. It is estimated that 78,720 and 1,18,080 man-days of direct and indirect employment were generated as a result of APCs established by AICRP on PHET. A good number of inspired APCs demonstrate its multiplier effect in terms of adoption. Overall, the APCs have contributed significantly towards income and employment generation.

## The Potential Benefit

It has been hypothesized that with the establishment of processing centres or units, existing post-harvest losses, which occurred due to non-availability of processing and post-harvest infrastructure facilities, can be minimized upto 30 per cent of what they were in 2015. These agro processing centres, if

established, at national level for a cluster of 4-5 villages or at block level and used by the community on custom-hiring basis, there will be an increase in the value addition of the raw produce by 10-15 per cent. For establishment of these processing units, fixed capital of INR 15-20 lakh and working capital of INR 10-15 lakh is required. With proper packaging and brand development, the income generated with this investment is about 4-5 lakh per annum. Hence, this processing and value addition of raw produce can enhance the income of the farmers by 35-40 per cent.

Based on an assumption that if at least 30 per cent of the quantity of food grains lost is processed, an average of INR 11809.59 Crore will be saved per annum. If 20 per cent of total production is made available for processing through APCs with 5 per cent higher price realization an additional income to the tune of INR 20438.63 Crore per annum will be available for the farming community.

### 3 DETAILS OF SOME SUCCESSFUL APC's

Agro processing is a set of techno economic activity carried out for conservation and handling of agricultural produce and to make it usable as food, feed, fibre, fuel or industrial raw material. Properly developed agro-processing sector does not only encourage rural entrepreneurship, but also help make the nation a major player at the global level for marketing and supply of processed food, feed and a wide range of other plant and animal products. Making things available for local consumption thus reducing on the transportation cost, making the machinery available for custom hiring giving year-round employment to local people and processing speciality local product for long distance markets are some of the added advantages with establishment of APCs in production catchment.

ICAR had recognized that establishment of multi machinery, multi-commodity processing centers would be a viable proposition wherein variety of machines with reasonable capacities could be installed and some of such machines could perform in processing of more than one crop. Further, it was noted that certain geographic locations have advantage of certain production or demand, hence specialized product-based APCs were also promoted.

Hand-holding in the form of training, advice in machine selection, branding and marketing and problem solving was provided during the course of establishment and operation of such APCs. These efforts resulted in establishment of around 300 APCs; some of them stopped their operations due to financial or some other reasons, however as of now around 270 APCs are in operation. Punjab has maximum number (93) of APC established followed by Karnataka (35) and Maharashtra (18).

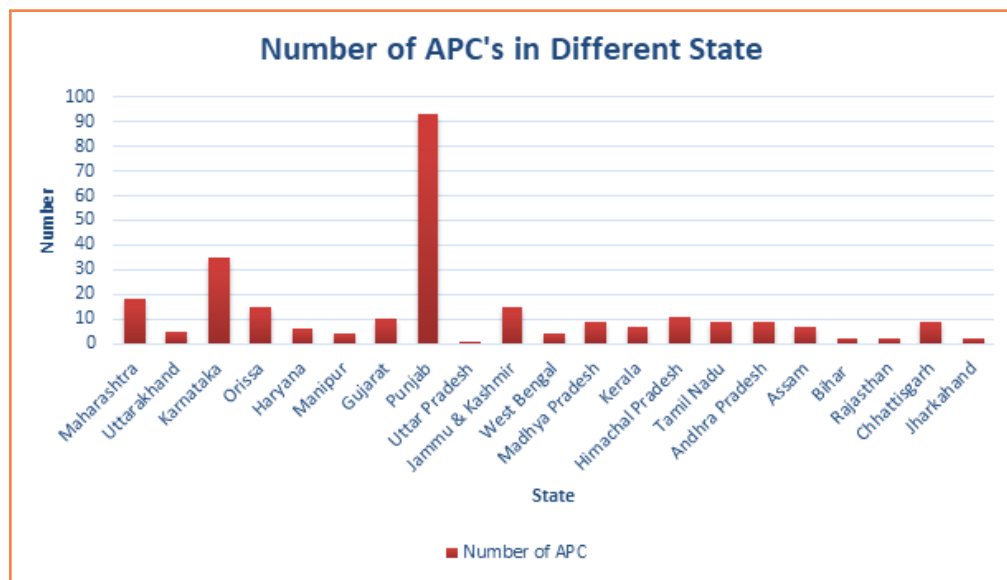


Fig 4: Number of APC's established in different states

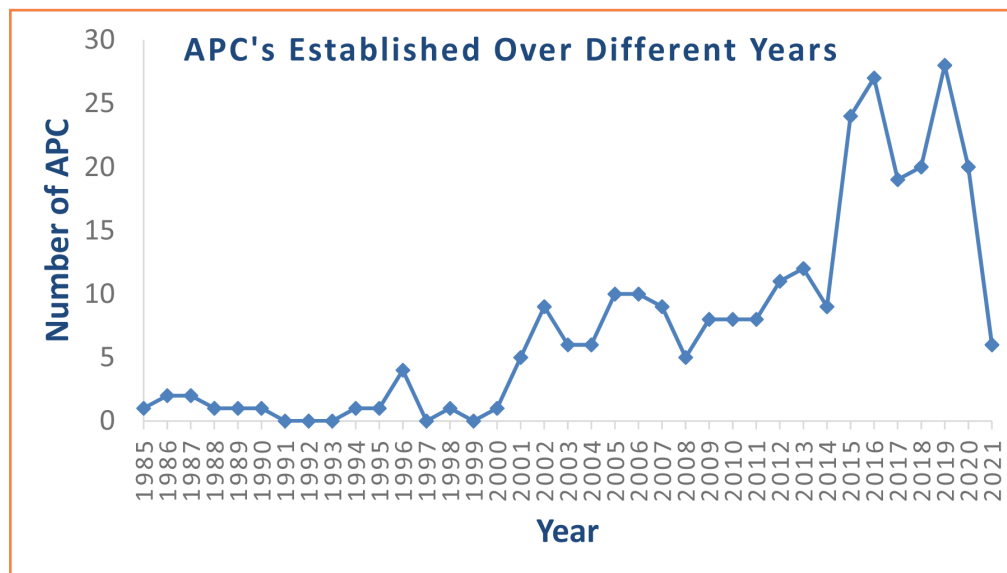
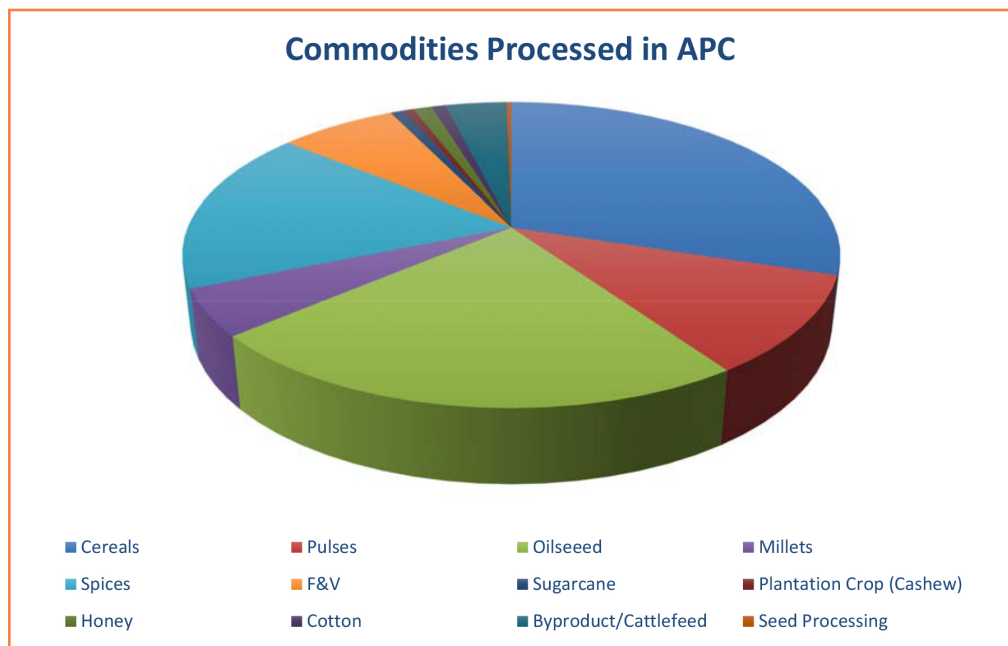


Fig 5: Number of APC's established over time

## CONSTRAINTS

The constraints faced by the farmer-entrepreneurs could be categorized into two groups; (1) Constraints in establishment and (2) Constraints in operations/running the APC. These constraints have been listed below but not necessarily in the order of importance.

- (a) Lack of awareness about post handling practices
- (b) Low-capacity machines, which could be less efficient and less economical to operate
- (c) Inadequate capacity utilization of the installed facility
- (d) Poor recovery of the finished product from the raw materials
- (e) Supply of finance, problems of arranging adequate working capital and its management, lack of access to credit
- (f) Low product quality due to non-availability of quality raw material
- (g) Non uniformity in quality of produce across time and geography
- (h) Unreliable/ inadequate power supply
- (i) Suggesting appropriate technology and impart necessary training
- (j) Assistance in marketing
- (k) Lack of technical guidance
- (l) Risk element
- (m) Dependence on monsoon
- (n) Inadequate storage facilities
- (o) Promotional activities are inadequate



- (p) Uncertainty about future market demand/ no access to market intelligence/ lack of information on different markets
- (q) Poor transportation and market infrastructure etc.
- (r) Seasonal supply of produce may lead to under-utilization of unit
- (s) Lack of co-ordination among different development agencies
- (t) Unavailability of machines for processing of multi-commodity

## 5 WAY FORWARD

Establishment of agro-based industries in rural areas have been in focus of planners, financial institutions, rural development agencies and R&D institutions. Such industries, through value-addition activities of agriculture produce and utilization of agricultural wastes/ residues/ by-products for food, feed, fuel and other industrial products, can make immense change in the rural economy. These agro-processing enterprises, preferably of small scale or cottage sector, would not need huge capital requirement. A number of low/ medium capacity and low-cost bankable technologies have been available which could be used for agro-processing activities of cereals, pulses, oilseeds, spices, horticulture/ plantation crops, animal products, etc. Small machinery with appropriate capacity and efficiencies are now available for use by farmers, leading to loss prevention and value addition to different commodities. Following is a SWOT analysis of the post-harvest agriculture sector in respect of establishing Agro Processing Centers in the production catchment/ rural setup.

### Various Government Schemes for supporting agro-processing

Government of India is promoting micro, medium and small enterprises through its various schemes. Some of the schemes that are beneficial for farmers and entrepreneurs to start agribusiness are listed below:

#### a) **PM-Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PMFME):**

This scheme is for providing financial, technical and business support for upgrading of existing micro food processing enterprises. The main objectives of the scheme are (i) Support for capital investment for up gradation and formalization with registration for GST, FSSAI hygiene standards and Udyog Aadhar (ii) Capacity building through skill training, imparting technical knowledge on food safety standards and hygiene and quality improvement (iii) Hand holding support for preparation of DPR, availing bank loan and up gradation (iv) Support to FPOs, SHGs, Producer cooperatives. These objectives are achieved through:

- i. ***One District One Product approach (ODOP)*** - ODOP approach is to reap the benefit of scale in terms of procurement of inputs, availing common services, branding and marketing of products. This approach would provide framework for value chain development and alignment of support infrastructure. There may be more than one cluster for one product in one district. A cluster may also extend beyond one district. The states would identify food product for a district, keeping in perspective the focus of the scheme on perishables.

- ii. ***Up gradation of individual micro food processing unit*** - unit can avail credit linked capital subsidy @ 35 % of eligible project cost with a maximum ceiling of INR10 lakh. Here the minimum beneficiary contribution is kept as 10% and balance should be bank loan
- iii. ***Support to FPOs/ SHGs/ Cooperatives*** - provides support for capital investment along the entire value chain with credit linked grant @ 35%
- iv. ***Seed Capital to SHG involved in food processing*** - @ INR 40,000/- per SHG member is provided for working capital and purchase of small tools
- v. ***Common Infrastructure*** - credit linked grant @ 35% provided to FPOs/ SHGs/ Cooperatives/ state owned agencies and private agencies for developing common infrastructure
- vi. ***Branding and Marketing Support*** - Provided at state or region level following the ODOP approach. Support is limited to 50% of the total expenditure

#### **b) Pradhan Mantri MUDRA Yojana (PMMY):**

MUDRA provides refinance support to Banks, Micro Finance Institutions and Non-Banking Financial Companies for lending to micro units having loan requirement upto INR 10 lakh. MUDRA has created three loan schemes named ‘Shishu’, ‘Kishore’ and ‘Tarun’ to signify the stage of growth or development and funding needs of the beneficiary micro unit or entrepreneur

- **Shishu:** Covers loan up to INR 50,000/- particularly for entrepreneurs who are in the initial stage of starting venture or require less fund
- **Kishor:** Covers loan above INR 50000/- and up to INR 5 lakh. Those who require this much fund to start business or those who want to expand their already established business can make use of this scheme
- **Tarun:** Covers loan above INR 5 lakh and up to INR 10 lakhs

The loan is provided by commercial banks, Regional Rural Banks (RRBs), Small Finance Banks, Non-Banking Financial Companies and microfinance institutions. The borrower can approach any of these lending institutions or can apply online through the portal [www.udyamimitra.in](http://www.udyamimitra.in).



### **c) NABARD-Agriclinics and Agri-Business Centres Scheme:**

Agri-Business Centres are commercial units of agri-ventures established by trained agriculture graduates. Such ventures may include maintenance and custom hiring of farm equipment, sale of inputs and other services in agriculture and allied areas, including post-harvest management and market linkages for income generation and entrepreneurship development. The scheme covers full financial support for training and handholding, provision of loan and credit linked back ended composite subsidy. National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE) is responsible for providing training to eligible candidates, through Nodal Training Institutes (NTIs) and motivating them for setting up of AgriClinics and Agri-Business Centres. Individual will get subsidy upto INR 20 lakh and INR 100 lakh in case of group project. The subsidy can be repaid within 5-10 years on easy instalment plans. Applications can be submitted online on <http://www.agriclinics.net/onlineform.htm>.

### **d) Small Farmers' Agriculture- Business Consortium- Agriculture Business Development**

This scheme provides venture capital in the form of equity for individuals, farmers, SHGs, producer group, agripreneurs, partnership or propriety firms etc. Maximum financial assistance is up to INR 5 lakh. One can apply for the assistance to Agricultural Marketing Adviser/ Joint Secretary (Marketing), DAC&FW, New Delhi or to Managing Director, SFAC.

### **e) Post-Harvest Technology and Management**

This scheme provides 100 per cent grant-in-aid for purchase of machinery and contingency expenses for setting up units using post-harvest technologies and management, value addition, by-product management etc. Individual farmers, SHGs, cooperatives etc. can apply for the grant to Joint Secretary (M&T), DAC&FW, New Delhi.

### **f) Sub Mission on Agricultural Mechanisation (SMAM)**

Under this scheme for establishing post-harvest technology units in the production catchments, 60 per cent subsidy is provided for SC, ST, small and marginal farmers, women and NE state beneficiaries and 50 per cent for other beneficiaries. This subsidy can be used for procuring primary processing technologies, value addition, low-cost storage, packaging units and technologies for by-product utilization. Individual farmers, SHGs, cooperatives etc. can contact District Agriculture Officer/ District Horticulture Officer or Project Director ATMA for availing this scheme.
